- Busy start to the year
- Steady enrollment over the summer
- Lots of extra-curricular up and running ( over 100 students are currently participating in Cross Country) Borden ball and two softball teams playing, primary and junior choir have started, student committees organized(student equity, social justice, eco team) -- strong emphasis on holistic learning
- New permanent ECE has been added to 2<sup>nd</sup> Kindergarten Classroom due to increase in enrollment numbers
- Playground – TDSB has approved design and terms of reference with hopes of installation for the spring of 2017
  - TDSB will be assigning a project contact/designer to work on the project
- Simcoe has been recertified as a “gold certified” school – eco school
- New gifted screening program has come into effect – new universal screening – all (informed consent) students in grade 3 will be participating in the cognitive screening
- Arlene to determine when and if parents receive the screening results.
