##### • **Meeting Report/Recap provided by Jason**

- Pupil Accomodation Review (PARC) currently underway

- TDSB initiated review in 2017 to address low enrolment and underutilization at Guildwood Junior Public School and Jack Miner Senior Public School, along with facility conditions at Elizabeth Simcoe Junior Public School, Guildwood Junior Public School, and Poplar Road Junior Public School.
- On June 21, 2017, the Board of Trustees decided to reconvene the PARC process to consider a new option that includes the closure of Jack Miner Senior Public School and the grade expansion of Elizabeth Simcoe Junior Public School, Guildwood Junior Public School, and Poplar Road Junior Public School to Junior Kindergarten to Grade 8.
- Representatives from the board met with the community and all of schools potentially impacted on respective nights
- Elizabeth Simcoe meeting led by Jerry Chadwick, Kerry-Lynn Stadnyk and Andrew Howard
- Some accommodations/modifications would be required at Elizabeth Simcoe
- PARC committee meeting again on April 16
- Community Meeting at Sir Wilfrid Laurier HS on April 24
- TDSB Board Vote on proposal June 20
